2013 Bin 5757 Chardonnay

Sonoma County

Nestled in the pristine Bennett Valley appellation in Sonoma County, Bennett Valley Cellars farms 40 acres of estate Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Our well-drained alluvial (volcanic) soils and fog-cooled climate create an ideal growing environment for producing world-class wines. The result is wine with flavors and aromatic characteristics unique to this beautiful valley.

Bin 5757 Unoaked Chardonnay represents the second release of the sister wine to the our Bin 6410 Pinot Noir.

Dijon and Wente clone grapes were hand-picked and then sorted at the winery to ensure that only intact fruit was vinified. This wine is 95% Chardonnay, with 5% Muscat for an intriguing floral quality, stainless steel fermented, and spends no time in oak barrels. In keeping with the owners' European roots, it is reminiscent of a lean but effusive Chablis.

Taut but expressive, this wine offers fresh apple and pear flavors, enhanced by a flinty minerality. The crisp acid finish makes this wine a perfect companion to fresh shellfish or even your spiciest dish! It is a wine to enjoy with friends and creative cuisine!
