Produced from Estate grown fruit in the northern reaches of the Dry Creek Valley. This vibrant, yet ripe Sauvignon Blanc displays bright notes of jasmine, peach, and wet stone. A lush mid-palate is balanced by lively acidity and hint of vanilla on the finish.

Production Notes:

The fruit for this wine was whole cluster pressed. 60% of the Sauvignon Blanc was tank fermented to enhance the aromatics and crispness inherent in the fruit. The remaining 40% was native-yeast barrel fermented in French Oak to subtly soften and enhance the mouthfeel.
